Event Terms and Conditions

1. These Event Conditions apply to the 'School Holidays Plush 2026 ("Event")', provided by GPT Property Management Pty Limited ABN 29 116 099 631 of Level 15, 2 Park Street, Sydney NSW 2000 ("Organiser") in conjunction with various Partners ("Partner").
2. Entry and participation in the Event are subject to these Event Terms and Conditions.
3. This Event is for participants aged 4+ years old, whose guardians purchase a ticket to the event outlined in the Humanitix event listing.
4. All participants under the age of 18 must receive permission from a parent/guardian to participate and must be accompanied and supervised by a parent/guardian during the Event.
5. The Event will be conducted at Centre Court located on Level 1, near Kmart at Macquarie Centre ("Event Location").
6. You must be aged 18 or over to book for the Event.
7. Bookings may be made online at <https://events.humanitix.com/school-holidays-plush-2026> ("Booking Website") between Wednesday 23 September 2026, 9:00am AEST and Sunday 11 October 2026, 2:59pm AEST while tickets last. All bookings are subject to availability. Your booking only takes effect when you receive email confirmation of your booking.
8. Tickets are \$5 each, unless otherwise specified on the Humanitix event listing.
9. A confirmation email will be sent from Humanitix to the Customer with a unique QR code to present at the time of the Event. The QR code represents one ticket and can only be presented once. Admission to the Event will not be permitted without the presentation of a valid QR code/ticket.
10. Online bookings are subject to additional terms and conditions reasonably imposed by the booking provider HUMANITIX LIMITED, ABN 32 618 780 439 including those available at https://static.humanitix.com/pdfs/attendee_terms.pdf.

12. Each ticket to the Event includes the following:

13. All Event staff that interact with children at the Event will hold a valid Working with Children Check.
14. If you wish to change the time/day of your Event session, you must visit the Humanitix website or click the link included in your order confirmation and contact the organiser at least 24 hours before your booking to reschedule. We will endeavour to reschedule your booking to an alternative session, subject to availability.
15. If you can no longer attend your session and wish to cancel your booking, you must request this through the Humanitix booking site and contact the organiser at macquarie.marketing@gpt.com.au

16. You must arrive at the Event Location 10 minutes before your session time and present your booking confirmation email and /or QR Code to Event staff upon arrival.
17. Failure to check in on time may result in missing The Event.
18. You, and individuals attending under your booking (including children and companions), must:
 - a. Comply with all reasonable instructions and directions (including in relation to safety and security) provided by Event staff and authorised personnel associated with the Event including authorised personnel of the Organiser and Partners.
 - b. Behave in an appropriate manner at all times during the Event. The Organiser reserves the right to refuse entry to the Event if inappropriate behaviour (as determined by the Organiser acting reasonably) is exhibited.
 - c. Inform the Organiser and Partner of any allergies or medical conditions (including skin allergies/ conditions) when purchasing the Event ticket via Humanitix or upon arrival at the Event.
 - d. Agree and acknowledge that attendees are responsible for their personal belongings. The Organiser and Partner are not liable for any lost or stolen items.
19. You, and any individuals attending under your booking (including children and companions) must not:
 - a. engage in any conduct that may jeopardise the proper conduct of the Event or the health and safety of staff or participants;
 - b. engage in any conduct that may result in physical damage at the Event Location;
 - c. act in a disruptive, annoying, threatening, abusive or harassing manner, or any other manner that is otherwise inappropriate;
 - d. do anything that may diminish the good name or reputation of the Organiser or related entities or of the agencies or companies associated with this Event; or
 - e. breach any laws.
20. If you or any individuals attending under your booking (including children and companions) act in the above manner or otherwise materially breach these Event Conditions, you and those individuals may be refused entry or asked to leave the Event Location and be restricted from participating in the Event, in the Organiser's (or its authorised personnel's) reasonable discretion.
21. In order to manage your booking, communicate with you and conduct this Event, the Organiser and/or Partner involved may collect personal information about each participant specified in a booking (including through HUMANITIX LIMITED) and may, for this purpose, disclose such information to third parties, including the Organiser's and/or Partner's contractors and agents for the purpose of conducting the Event. Participation in the Event is conditional on providing this personal information.
22. Your personal information will be collected by the Organiser. Personal information will be stored on the Organiser's database. The Organiser may use this information for future marketing purposes regarding its products, including contacting the entrant electronically. The Organiser is bound by the Australian Privacy Principles in accordance with the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth) and its privacy policy which is located at www.gpt.com.au/privacy-policy. The Organiser's privacy policy contains information about how the entrant may access, update and seek correction of the personal information the Organiser holds about them and how the entrant may complain about any potential breach by the Organiser of the Australian Privacy Principles or any other Australian privacy laws and how such complaints will be dealt with. The Organiser collects personal information about entrants to enable them to participate in this Event and may disclose the entrants' personal information to third parties including its contractors and agents.

By ordering a ticket and/or attending the Event and accepting these Terms and Conditions, you are agreeing that you have read (and accepted) the Organiser's privacy policy.
24. By ordering a ticket for the Event, you consent to the Organiser keeping your personal information on its database to use for future marketing purposes, including contacting you by electronic messaging provided that where required by the Spam Act 2003 (Cth), the Organiser includes a functional unsubscribe facility in each direct marketing communication it sends you that you may use to opt-out of any further such communications and provided that the functional unsubscribe facility complies with the Spam Regulations 2021 (Cth). By ordering a ticket, you consent to receive email or SMS messages from the Organiser without any functional unsubscribe facility if they relate primarily to the conduct of this Event.
25. You agree that, by attending the Event:
- a. you and any individuals attending under your booking (including any children and companions) may be photographed and/or filmed by the Organiser's and/or Partner authorised personnel;
 - b. the images and/or film may be used for future promotional and marketing purposes by the Organiser and/or Partner with no remuneration or compensation; and
 - c. you must not photograph or film other participants at the Event without first obtaining their express consent.
26. By making a booking and/or attending the Event, you accept these Event Conditions, forming an agreement between you and the Organiser (each, a "Party"). If you are making a booking for any minors (being participants under the age of 18), you accept these Event Conditions both on your own behalf and on behalf of the minor/s, as applicable.
27. The Partner is a third party which is separate from the Organiser. The Organiser is not responsible for the conduct of the Partner or any other third parties that are otherwise associated with the Event.
28. The Organiser may make changes to Event (that do not substantially vary the event).
29. The Organiser may reschedule or delay the Event if it determines it is reasonably necessary to do so upon written notice to you.
30. If the Event is interfered with or is not capable of being conducted as reasonably anticipated due to events or reasons beyond the reasonable control of the Organiser (for example, due to security or operational reasons, weather conditions, government directives, a pandemic, public health orders and the like), the Organiser may terminate, suspend or cancel the Event in its reasonable discretion, and if practicable, provide you with reasonable notice.
31. You may have consumer rights under statute including under the Australian Consumer Law ("ACL") in the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* (Cth), which may be applicable to the supply of goods or services by us in relation to this Event and cannot be excluded or restricted. Nothing in these Event Conditions excludes or restricts those rights. See www.accc.gov.au for more information about those rights.
32. To the extent permitted by law, if the Organiser's or Partner supply of goods or services in connection with the Event or under these Event Conditions is within the meaning prescribed under the ACL, then the Organiser's or Partner liability (as applicable) for any failure to comply with a statutory guarantee, condition or warranty that cannot be excluded under statute is limited to (at the Organiser's or Partner's choice (as applicable)):
- a. in the case of services; the cost of supplying the services again or payment of the cost of having the services supplied again; and

- b. in the case of goods; the cost of replacing the goods, supplying equivalent goods or having the goods repaired, or payment of the cost of replacing the goods, supplying equivalent goods or having the goods repaired.
- 33. By ordering a ticket and attending the Event, you acknowledge that the Organiser, the owner of Macquarie Shopping Centre and their associated agencies, related companies, officers, employees and contractors are not and will not be liable for any loss (including, without limitation, indirect, special or consequential loss or loss of profits), expense, damage, personal injury or death which is suffered or sustained (whether or not arising from any person's negligence or wilful misconduct) in connection with:
 - a. the Event generally;
 - b. attendance at the Event;
 - c. cancellation or postponement of the Event;
 - d. use of photographs, video or images;
 - e. any technical difficulties or equipment malfunction (whether or not under the Organiser's control); or
 - f. any theft, unauthorised access or third party interference, except for any liability which cannot be excluded by law (in which case that liability is limited to the minimum allowable by law) or any liability which is caused by the negligent, reckless or intentional act or omission of the abovenamed parties.
- 34. All references to the Organiser are references to the Organiser and the Organiser's 'related entities' as defined under the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth).
- 35. The Organiser is the copyright owner of the material on the Booking Website or is licensed by the copyright owner to use such material on the Booking Website. All trademarks, brands, names and other intellectual property appearing on the Booking Website are the property of their respective owners.
- 36. You are not granted any rights, title or interest in the material on the Booking Website. You must not adapt, reproduce, publish, distribute or transmit any of the material on the Booking Website without the express written consent of the Organiser and any other relevant intellectual property rights owners (as applicable).
- 37. In these Event Conditions, "including" is not a word of limitation.
- 38. The Organiser may assign, novate or otherwise deal with any of its rights or obligations under these Event Conditions without obtaining your consent, if to do so will be unlikely to cause any material detriment to you.
- 39. If any provision of these Event Conditions is unlawful or unenforceable, the remaining provisions will continue in full force and effect.
- 40. These Event Conditions are governed by the laws of New South Wales, Australia and the parties irrevocably submit to the jurisdiction of the courts having jurisdiction in New South Wales, Australia.
